Our Goal: is to advance the treatment and prevention of skin cancer under the expertise and guidance of a board-certified plastic surgeon with special interests in dermatology and dermatologic surgery. We have two locations serving the Delaware Valley and DelMarVa Peninsula: Newark & Rehoboth Beach. We perform skin cancer removals using a modified form of the Mohs technique called "Modified Mohs/ Frozen section procedure".

Our personal experience: over 5 thousand skin cancer removals performed by one plastic surgeon over the past 20+ years; currently 700-800+ modified Mohs procedures performed yearly by the same surgeon.

*Our center accepts Medicare and most commercial insurances

Traditional MOHs vs Modified MOHs (differences):

- For all cases (100%), the same physician (board certified Plastic Surgeon) performs the removal and immediate closure of the skin cancer procedure while a board-certified pathologist performs the microscopic analysis of the skin cancer removal
- Patient is placed in a treatment room and never leaves the same treatment room until entire procedure is done
- 3. Average treatment time in the room is under 45 minutes
- >95% of all skin cancer removals are performed in the office setting under local anesthesia
- The entire insurance costs including surgical removal, microscopic analysis, surgical closure and office facility fees are at least 1/2 - 1/3 the cost associated with traditional Mohs procedures

Traditional MOHs & Modified MOHs (similarities):

- 99+% success rate in skin cancer removal
- Immediate microscopic analysis of the tissue margins to ensure complete removal of the skin cancer.

Our center: we provide comprehensive skin cancer care whose mission is to advance the treatment and prevention of skin cancer. Services include screenings, body photography, cryotherapy, topical chemotherapy, biopsies, and lasers under the care of 4 board certified physician assistants specializing in plastic surgery and dermatology. These talented physician assistants are under either direct and/or indirect supervision from a board-certified plastic surgeon.
